

Abstract

China has emerged and progressed at a high pace in the world. China's administrative policy towards Hong Kong is an interesting topic in the current scenario. It's been 22 years since Hong Kong came under Chinese sovereignty. It is one of the Special Administrative Region of the China along Taiwan and Macau. China gave it high level of autonomy and promised to retain the capitalist system in running economic affairs of the region. Now, China is an important part of global politics and Chinese stake in resolving global issues has maximized. Hong Kong is not only part of China but it also has the worldwide significance. The practice of two contrasting systems, communism in mainland and capitalist in the region has attracted many research scholars. The implementation of Chinese Policy towards Hong Kong under the principle of One Country Two Systems can be analyzed in qualitative way. Both primary and secondary sources of data have been used to explore the aspects of topic under study. Open ended interviews of ten people from various fields were conducted by the researcher. Respondents include former ambassador to Hong Kong, solicitors, officials, personal staff members of the Chief Executive of Hong Kong, policy formulators and some nationals. The findings of the study prove that Hong Kong is governed under the rigid policies of Beijing and want to assimilate the region into One China.
