Abstract

Pakistan's independence was only the freedom from British rule and Hindu dominance because since its inception it was captive of many challenges including not contiguous territory, migration, delay in constitution making, leadership crisis, dysfunctional federation, ethnic differences, sectarianism, border clashes and many more. After the incident of September 11, 2001 Pakistan feces the brutal challenge of Terrorism that hits every sector of country and creates the environment of anxiety and insecurity. To counter the challenge of Terrorism many military operations were held in Pakistan and for the long term positive results many policy options were opted that include ATA, NACTA, NISP, NAP and military courts.
