Abstract

Better education ultimately leads a society to better health care, better social life, law and justice etc. Lack of women education in southern district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Lakki Marwat which include many problems some general and some specifically related to this region. Culturally it is considered not good to let women outside of your home which is the main barrier for women of not getting education. Early marriage halts the education of women and women could not pursue her education due to extra responsibility after marriage. Lack of women education in the region is also mainly due lack of women schools, colleges and universities. There are only two higher secondary schools for women and two colleges and no women university for a population of 443000. Co-education is culturally not accepted in the society due to which drop of at each higher level of education get high and high due to a smaller number of available schools and colleges. Most of the families do not let their women to far flung schools and colleges due to unavailability of transportation facilities. Economic situation of most of the families are good enough to afford their children education. All these issues can be addressed through social mobilization campaign to understand the masses the female education is as important as male education. Religious scholar can be helpful to understand the masses the importance of female education and their impact on the lives of families and on whole society. An attractive culturally acceptable activities needs to be initiated in the educational institute. An initiative of stipend for female student initiated shall be increased as it is attracting more students. A handsome salary for female teachers, increase in the number of schools and facilities in the school can be very helpful in flourishing female education. Easy access to the far-flung schools can be made possible with good road infrastructure and transportation facility will prove helpful in promoting girl's education in the southern district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Lakki Marwat.
