

ABSTRACT

This phenomenon got Strength with the Enforcement programmes of UNDP in Developing Countries and remained an important feature of 21st century Development Agenda. I tried to find that difficulties and problems in Pakistan since its Birth 1947-2002 which are hindered in the attainment of development Levels that ensure Sustainable Human development in the Country.

The area of study chosen is Pakistan, as the country is the classical example where development never persists and variations came in the history. At certain phases the country moved on such a point that it was about to enter in the list of developed countries and at other times the whole economy collapsed and we stood on the brink of being declared as defaulter. The country's economic difficulties are the result of economic mismanagement in key areas and ignorance of social sector reforms over long periods. Bad governance as reflected in wide spread corruption, poor delivery of public services, debt trap and low economic growth have given birth to a crisis of confidence in the state.
